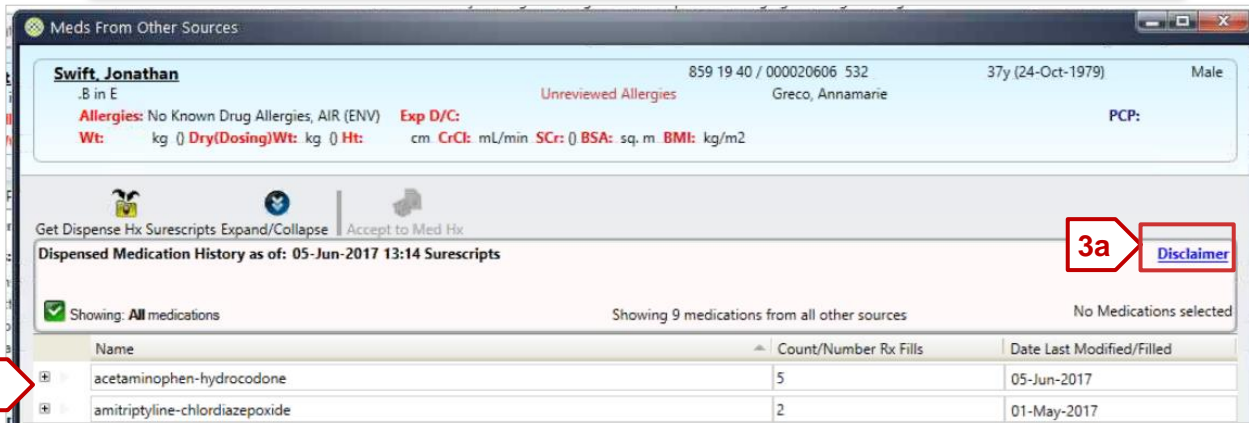
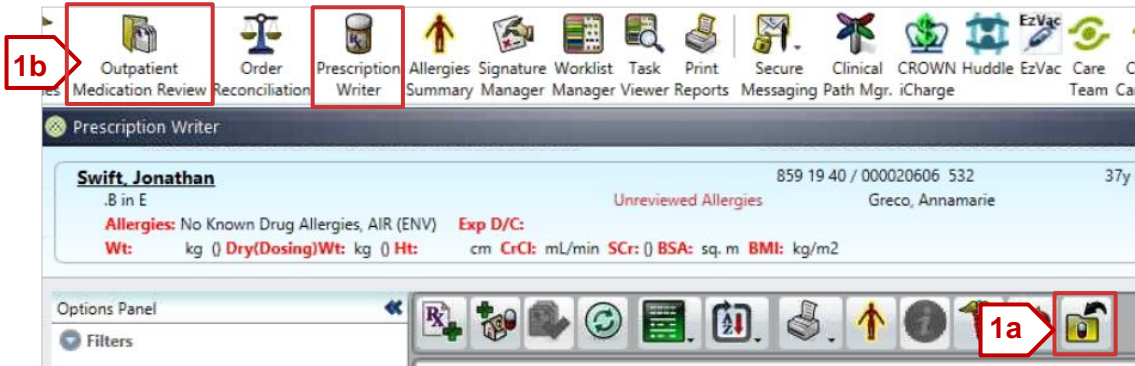




Allscripts SCM Dispensed Medication History

Dispensed Medication History is also known as Dispense Drug History (DDH) or Medications from Other Sources. The information is based on insurance claim data, and includes the patient's current and past prescriptions across multiple clinicians and pharmacies. This functionality can be used to improve the patient's home medication reconciliation process.

1. Meds from Other Source

Meds from Other Source (1a) can be accessed from both the Outpatient Medication Review and also the Prescription Writer (1b).

2. Dispensed Medication History

Click the Meds from Other Source folder icon to view the Dispensed Medication History List. This list is populated based on the patient's insurance claim records. It includes prescriptions from the past 24 months, and is updated every 24 hours.

3. Disclaimer

Hover over the Disclaimer link (3a) to view details (3b). **The Meds from Other Sources Disclaimer information may be incomplete or inaccurate; clinicians should always verify past medications with patient instead of relying entirely on the displayed list.**

4. Dispensed Medication History Details/History

Click the + (- shown because + was previously clicked) next to a listed medication to view the details—each instance that medication was prescribed and filled. Each item includes the medication name, strength, quantity, pharmacy and prescriber. The frequency, indication, and route, although required in OMR, are not included in this record.

5. Accept to Med Hx

To add a historical medication to the patient's Outpatient Medication Review, click to select a medication (5a), then click **Accept to Med Hx** (5b or right-click to 5c). **Further reconciliation is required.**

6. Binoculars

The binoculars icon will appear to warn you that this may be a duplicate entry. Review and visually confirm.

7. Outpatient Medication History

Proceed to Outpatient Medication Review to complete the reconciliation for the medication that was just added. Whenever you add a medication to OMR from the Dispense Medication History records, you will always need to edit the record (7a) to add the frequency, indication, and route before you reconcile (click the green check, 7b).
